Amnesty Programme for Illegal Immigrants in Malaysia

The Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of Malaysia has announced an Amnesty Programme called **"Back For Good Programme"**, from 1 August to 31 December 2019, to provide an opportunity to immigrants, that have either overstayed in Malaysia or those staying in Malaysia without valid pass or permit, to return to their respective countries. The basic features of the programme are as follows:

- The programme is coordinated by Immigration Department of Malaysia with **no appointment of outside agents**.
- Foreigners should have valid travel documents i.e. **Passport/Emergency Certificate**.
- Foreigners should have **ticket** to go back to their home countries **within 7 days**.
- A compound payment of **RM700** (**Ringgit Seven Hundred only**) to be paid.

Indian nationals eligible to be covered under this programme can register with the various immigration offices listed in the link above.

Those Indian nationals who do not possess valid travel documents may apply for Emergency Certificate (EC) at the outsourced agency of High Commission of India at M/s BLS International Limited, Level 4, Wisma Tancom, 326-328 Jalan Tuanku Abdul Rahman, 50100 Kuala Lumpur, [Telephone Nos. 03 26022474 and 03 26022476].

High Commission of India urges all Indian nationals, who have overstayed in Malaysia for whatever reasons to take advantage of this opportunity to return to India.
