


WORLD FOOD INDIA 2019

The event was inaugurated by Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi on 3rd November 2017 and witnessed participation of 61 countries including 7 International Ministers, 9 Ministerial / Official delegations and 15 business delegations, 11 International Business Chambers. Germany, Denmark and Japan were Partner Countries while Italy and Netherlands were the Focus countries.


