

FLIGHT INFORMATION : SPECIAL FLIGHTS TO INDIA

The Government of India has permitted to allow special flights, on commercial basis, for repatriation of Indian Nationals stranded in Malaysia.

The flights have started operations from Kuala Lumpur Airport to select destinations in India, **in a phased manner**. Those Indian Nationals in distress and those with compelling reasons to return to India are being given priority. **Since all registered nationals may not have their names in initial flights, we request you to exercise patience and wait for your turn in case not listed initially.**

Kindly be advised that **passengers will have to bear the cost of airfare and also have to undergo compulsory 14 days quarantine at their own cost** after reaching India.

The High Commission of India, Kuala Lumpur is individually calling up each passenger to ascertain his/her willingness to travel. There are certain guidelines for the passengers: -

- (i) In view of the emerging Covid-19 situation, affected Nationals are **requested to only opt for the airport in their home state for travel & provide their address accordingly.**
- (ii) **The flights have restricted seats and hence few passengers would be waitlisted.** The waitlisted passengers are requested to be ready at short notice to move to the airport for ticketing.
- (iii) **The flight information is being disseminated to individual passengers who have been slotted in each flight.**
- (iv) Special authority letter/ permission from the High Commission will be given to passengers for their move to Airport.
