

Advisory for Indian nationals

The Immigration Department, Government of Malaysia had announced a scheme for the benefit of undocumented foreign workers, currently in Malaysia whereby all undocumented foreign workers can leave the country voluntarily after payment of a fine of RM 500/-.

All Indian citizens in Malaysia who have overstayed and are willing to return to India are advised to take advantage of this programme (extended last date is 30 June, 2022). Please be advised not to fall victim to unscrupulous agents who claim that they can help with payment of immigration fine or re-hiring in any Company, since both these programmes are being directly managed by the Malaysian Immigration Department and there is no third party (Agent) involved in the process.

Kindly note that undocumented foreign workers who are unwilling to utilise the Recalibration programme (Return to home) or are found to be working under different employers without proper documentation are liable for enforcement action including detention during checking/raids by the Immigration Department, Government of Malaysia. Under the Malaysian law, the arrested person(s) can be subjected to imprisonment, fine or whipped upon conviction.

It is advised that all eligible undocumented Indian workers may avail this Recalibration programme (Return to home) as early as possible, the last date of which is 30 June 2022.
